SPECT (Single Photon Emission Computed Tomography)

CPT: 78807

- Known or suspected abscess of lung, mediastinum, peritoneum, retroperitoneum, intestine, liver, kidney, and urethra
- Osteomyelitis or Periostitis
- Osteomyelitis or Periostitis
- Amebic abscess of the liver, lung, or brain
- Tuberculous abscess of brain or spinal cord
- Cellulitis
- Infection or inflammatory reaction due to internal prosthetic device, implant, or graft
